Pierce Transit will run a Sunday schedule on **Independence Day**, Tuesday, July 4. Customer Service at Tacoma Dome Station will be closed with no bus phone service. You can always visit us online at <u>PierceTransit.org</u> for trip planning and other information.

#### 2023 JBLM Airshow & Warrior Expo

- Saturday, July 15 and Sunday, July 16
- Ride to and from the event **free** on board the Pierce Transit Express
- Pierce Transit will provide Express rides from Lakewood Station (11424 Pacific Highway SW) and the SR-512 Park & Ride (10617 S. Tacoma Way) to the event, with service running every 15 minutes between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

- This is JBLM's first airshow in seven years and it is free and open to the general public.

#### All Aboard the Gig Harbor Trolley

- The Trolley will provide rides between the downtown Gig Harbor waterfront district, Harbor Hill and the Uptown shopping district.
- Service starts July 1 and runs through Aug. 31.
- The Trolley also **connects with other routes** at the Kimball Drive Park & Ride.
- Fare is the same as a regular bus ride:
  - \$2 per ride or \$5 for an All Day Pass for adults
  - \$1 per ride or \$2.50 for an All Day Pass for those paying with an ORCA LIFT card or those who show a Regional Reduced Fare Permit.
  - Like all Pierce Transit services, **youth 18 and under ride free**.

## **ORCA LIFT at Pierce Transit**

- ORCA LIFT is a **reduced adult fare program** offered to individuals that meet the eligibility requirements of up to, or equal to, 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Level.
- If you qualify, you will **pay \$1 per one-way trip** on Pierce Transit buses and Runner services (Tideflats, Ruston, Spanaway, JBLM).
- Qualified individuals **pay reduced adult fare per one-way trip** with the following transit agencies:
  - Sound Transit services such as ST Express, Link Light Rail, Sounder Commuter Rail
  - King County Metro buses, Water Taxi, Seattle Monorail, Seattle Streetcar
  - Kitsap Transit buses
  - Everett Transit buses
  - Community Transit buses
- Applications can be **submitted in person** at Community Health Centers and Community Services offices around Pierce County.

## Free Youth Transit Pass Reminder

- Youth ages 18 and under can now ride fare free on public transit throughout our region.
- **Regional transit partners**, including Pierce Transit, offer free rides to youth.
- Young people who have an ORCA card are **strongly encouraged to register the card** online at <u>myORCA.com</u> or by stopping by our Customer Service Center at Tacoma Dome Station.
